

CALL FOR PAPERS

12th Beyond Basic Questions Workshop

28-29 June 2019 in Kiel, Germany

The 12th workshop “Beyond Basic Questions” (BBQ) will be hosted by the Research Area “Poverty Reduction, Equity, and Development” of the Kiel Institute for the World Economy (IfW) and take place in Haus Weltclub in Kiel, Germany, on 28-29 June 2019. The workshop brings together economists and other social scientists working on a wide range of policy-relevant research topics.

The goal of the workshop is to promote the exchange of ideas and discuss research in a friendly atmosphere. We will follow the tradition of the workshop and give young researchers priority in presenting their work. Senior researchers are encouraged, in particular, to act as discussants (but are also welcome to present a paper if they prefer to). Also following a 12-year old tradition, the workshop will include a BBQ and a (yet to be determined) social activity. This year’s event coincides with the [Kieler Woche](#), which is the world’s largest regatta and sailing event as well as one of Germany’s largest *Volksfeste*.

Submission of papers: Both empirical and theoretical papers will be considered. Please submit complete papers or extended abstracts (about 3 pages) by 15 March 2019 to sebastian.schmidt@hsu-hh.de. Preference will be given to full paper submissions. Decisions will be made by 22 March 2019.

Logistics: Kiel is located at the Baltic Sea with ferry connections to Sweden and Norway, has an ICE train station with direct connections to many German and Swiss cities, and is linked with a [shuttle service](#) to Hamburg Airport (approx. 1 hour). We offer accommodation for up to 30 participants directly at the conference venue for a small fee. Since it will be close to impossible to find affordable hotels in Kiel during the Kieler Woche, we will provide support for alternative accommodation arrangements if needed. Participants are expected to cover their own travel expenses. The workshops will start on Friday morning (28 June) and end on Saturday evening (29 June). On Thursday evening (27 June), we will organize a welcome dinner.
